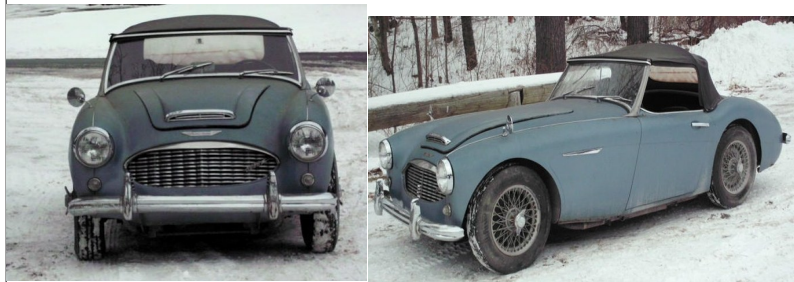

Tanglewood British Motorcar Festival
