
Winterization

Is it time to put the Healey away in mothballs for the Winter? If that's what you do, then its time. Personally, I go against the grain in that regard. My winterization includes fresh antifreeze, an oil change, and flushing of the brake fluid. Other than that, I keep her ready for that occasional mid-winter ride.. Of course I avoid the three S's ...Salt, Sand, & Snow; but it's a real treat to exercise the old beast on a brisk sunny day. Its good or my frame of mind, and its good for the car. I don't recommend just starting the car once in a while. Put some miles on it, get all the fluids warmed up and equilibrated, get the exhaust system hot to drive off moisture.

Also, it's a good idea to keep the top erected for the winter. It will keep its shape better, the wrinkles will have a chance to go away, and the critters won't be as likely to chew some holes in your Everflex.
