Modern Day Monet - THE 1st ANNUAL JURIED EXHIBITION





First Hands-on Tech Session of 2024

It was a full house at Peter Sturtevant's Garage in Mansfield, MA on January 3rd for the first Austin-Healey Club of New England, hands-on tech session of the year. Fifteen members and guests gathered to continue work on a Bugeye Sprite project owned by member Frank Jacques. Frank's Sprite was partially disassembled years ago and has been in dry storage since. The goal is to get the Sprite running in preparation for sale. In the previous tech session participants freed up a stuck valve, secured the motor mounts, cleaned, and adjusted the ignition points and installed the carburetors. While the engine work was being done, another crew attacked some knackered sheet metal at the rear of the car. When a temporary fuel supply was installed, it became clear that the carburetors needed rebuilding. They were shipped overnight to AHC-NE member and ardent club supporter Bob Abbott, British Car R&R, Ipswich, MA for rebuilding. Bob quickly turned the carburetors around and they were back in time for the January gathering where they were installed after which the engine started and ran quite nicely. Participants at the January tech session also partially disassembled an early 100-4 engine to evaluate its condition. The engine was mounted on a stand, the head was removed, and cylinders were cleaned and inspected. The bottom end will be inspected at the next gathering. At this point, the crew did some clean-up and prepared to go to lunch at nearby Kelly's restaurant where the fun continued over good food and spirited conversation. Plans are already set for the next and final session on Frank's car where a fuel line, exhaust and cooling system will be installed. Hands-on technical sessions are open to members wishing to participate. Watch for the announcement of the time and date and be sure to pre-register with Peter.

The Austin Healey Club of New England (AHCNE) is the largest club affiliated with the Austin Healey Club of America with over 350 members, and the largest geographic area. In fact, AHCNE welcomes many members who live outside the six New England states. In order to facilitate in-person meetings and gatherings AHCNE has been divided into seven geographic areas or Wings. This division was initially established using USPS area Zip Codes, but was not intended to create boundaries. ALL Wing activities are open to ALL AHCNE members. - Promote two-way communications with club Board of Directors.
- Identify and recruit members to assume leadership roles within AHCNE.
- Encourage members to organize periodic breakfast or dinner gatherings and bring guests.
- Remind members to promote AHCNE at local car events.
