

NUTS & BOLTS CORNER



Below are some of the recommendations made by Valve Cover Racer *Extraordinaire <mark>Jim Begin</mark> at our January 8th Technical Conference Call*



Special Tech Expert Jim Begin shared some of his secrets in building a valve cover racer. Jim is an acknowledged master of the valve cover race and has won on numerous occasions.

Jim Begin on the basics:



- •The Valve Cover Race Track is 16 ft long
- Two valve covers race side by side
- Any type of wheel or bearing may be used
- Only force of gravity moves car
- •The Valve Cover Racer *must* run through finish line
- •There are no restrictions on materials.
- •The VCR's length is not to exceed 28 inches, have not more than 6 wheels and its weight limit is 10 pounds

Jim Begin on the building your car:

- •Take a valve cover from any British engine and decorate it.
- You can find valve covers for sale on ebay
- •For participation in the Valve Cover Race at Summit, you may use the valve cover of any British car. Be creative in making it look like a proper LBC.
- •Start with base, leave cover off and built base first (use plywood 3/8" or 1/4" or go for an aluminum base)
- •Then install valve cover with screws to base
- Biggest problem is the alignment to make it go straight
- •Test it on a wooden floor, such as gym or anything with straight lines
- •Front wheels should not extend beyond the front of valve cover That makes it difficult to cross the finish line and would also give an unfair advantage
- •A member of the Tech Team mentioned that he used aluminum angle pieces, bolted them to the bottom of his plywood base. Then he made a rail to run front/aft on both sides and attached the wheels to the rail.

Jim Begin on wheels:

- •Good wheels to use are either the inline skater rubber wheel or those of two-wheel scooters, with a 2-4 inch diameter
- •Optimum wheel is 3-4 inch wheel
- •Jim has 6 inch wheels on his 'nasty boy' which are made out of Plexiglas, are hard and will run faster
- Inline skates also provide good bearings



- •Axle: depending on wheel hole size, cut a ¼ inch hole and put an acorn nut on the axle to prevent the wheel from coming off.
- Do not use a regular nut: when the car hits the side of the track, the acorn nut on the axle will allow it to continue to run



 A member of the Tech Team mentioned that he has a pivot point in the middle of his axle



 Another suggestion was to recycle an old cd-disk drive: the disks can be used as wheels and the drive provide good bearings

Jim Begin on ballast:

- •Weight limit is 10 lb, put weight into middle of car
- •What kind of ballast should you use? Be creative!
 Jim uses lead washers, which he made from chimney flashing.
 You may need to add approx. 4-5 lbs of ballast

We wish you a lot of fun with the contruction of your Valve Cover Racer and look forward to seeing lots of new VCR's at this year's Seaside Summit.

Another neat little technical trick from Jim Begin:



Here a little trick I have used over the years that works for me. When the air duct in the engine compartment gets scarred up after mechanical repairs, I use black liquid shoe polish to touch it up.

And voilá, as good as new!

Manny Cunard's Dream

The story starts with an email from Bob Moreau from the Mansfield Rotary Club. Bob told me of the story of another Rotary Club member who is battling lung cancer, Manny Cunard who has been restoring a BJ8 for the past seven years. Manny's Dream is to have the car completed and enjoy his labor of love, while he is still strong enough to enjoy it.



Manny is doing an incredible job with restoring his Healey in his one bay garage with parts being restored and prepared in the basement of his beautifully restored Victorian home from the 1870's.

He has sourced the best of available parts and materials and performing much of the restoration himself.

That includes rebuilding the engine himself. He performed all his own welding and body work, but hired a professional to apply a beautiful BMC deep blue color.

The car was originally Healey Blue with matching blue interior. The deep blue exterior paint is contrasted by a lovely custom biscuit leather interior and carpeting.

Time is of the essence, to help Manny finish his dream. This is his seventh restoration but first Healey. He sold a Jaquar E-type convertible to buy his BJ8 project in VA.






To help Manny Cunard continue the restoration of his BJ8

I am sure the neighbors were surprised that cold afternoon as Manny took his wife for their first drive together on the Healey with no body panels and only a pair of bucket seats and a new wooden steering wheel.

On Saturday afternoon I meet Manny for the first time to see the results of his labor of love. I was also able to take Manny for a spirited ride in my BJ8, so that he could experience the thrill of the brute power of mighty 6-cylinder engine.

Jud provided the 2017 Year in Review on the successes of AHC of NE including the Introduction of the Wing Concept. The monthly Tech Calls have been a great success as a new initiative last year. Members prefer emails as the primary source for notices of club events. The website members only section for Healey resources has been well received. The Healey Exhaust Notes (HEN) Newsletter has been a great means of sharing club news through the excellent work by Dutcha. The club's bylaws have been updated noting our not for profit status with the state of MA and we are approved with a 501 C status. Excellent work by Linda Hakala to complete all the documents with the state of MA.

Election of Officers – Jud

All current club officers, were nominated and all approved unanimously for re-elected to the positions as follows: Linda Hakala - Membership/Treasurer, Dutcha Slieker-Hersant - Publisher/Editor, Pete Sturtevant - Secretary/Webmaster, Steve Bell - National Delegate. There are two open Director positions for a VP and Ladies Coordinator. If anyone is interested in either of these two positions please self-nominate yourself for consideration.

Financial Report – Linda

The club continues to be in a very positive financial position with a checking balance of \$22k. Major income comes from the \$10 dues from New England member dues. The 2017 major expense was from the Bionic Pancreas charity collected last year, from the sale of F1 race our official charity. Additionally, we purchase new timing equipment for \$1200. The club was reinstated as a non-for-profit MA corporation in 2017. We need to file annual reports as a 990 filed on-line.

Membership Report – Linda

We ended 2017 with 326 members. 259 members have already renewed for 2018 and only 6 have confirmed they will not be renewing in 2018 because they have sold their cars. Only 61 members have yet to renew for 2018.

Newsletter Report – Dutcha

Analysis of the Healey Marque shows that in 2017 there were 6 feature articles published by AHC of NE members and 5 months in which articles from the *Healey Exhaust Notes* made it into Healey Marque. Quite impressive to see that we have so many prolific writers among our members.





This car was purchased in 2012, and it went through a 5 year 100% restoration by the owner. The car and every mechanical component was completely disassembled and restored and rebuilt. During this time the semi monocoque frame was mounted on a rotisserie for about 1 ½ years. Sandblasting, re-fabrication of



rusted parts, were reinstalled with painstaking welding and grinding. Sheet metal parts were hand embossed to match original parts exactly.

Rust preventative primers as well as filling primers, were applied to frame. Color coats as well as Urethane top coats completed the semi monocoque frame. There are approx. 1000 photographs of the restoration project.

All numbers match from chassis, body, engine, as well as all hidden parts, that were originally marked. All ID plates are original. British Heritage Certificate comes with the car.
