



## SUBJECTS COVERED DURING OUR NOVEMBER 2018 TECHNICAL CONFERENCE CALL

#### 1. INSTALLATION OF NEW SEAT FOAM

I purchased new seat covers and seat foam from Moss and am starting to install them into my BN2. I have read and seen videos where they glue felt to the top of the foam. Is this necessary to do this with the new seat foam? I assumed that the covers were not glued to the foam, but I have seen it done on a video.

#### **ADVICE:**

Advisor: replaced seat covers and foam in his BJ-8 and did not glue foam, except wrap around bottom of seat pan. He did not put felt on the foam. Merely replaced the foam, replaced the seat covers and that was that. Did this eight years ago and everything has held up fine.

Another Advisor mentioned that he had a chance to get a tour of Moss' trim room. It was a very impressive, all computerized system. The computer will figure out the best lay out of individual pieces and maximize material – it even recognizes imperfections in leather.

#### 2. DOOR SEALS BJ-8

This caller replaced door seals for his BJ8 some years ago, but they keep coming loose

#### **ADVICE:**

Bristol Flex has the better clamping system (available through Mark McGregor), which will stay on for a long time. Since this member did use the Bristol Flex seals, he may need to either squeeze the clips with pliers in order to stay on or use some type of glue/sealer to restore the door seal trim into place.

#### 3. WALNUT DASH INSTALLATION BJ8

This caller was looking for advice on how to install a new walnut dashboard in his BJ8

#### ADVICE:

The technical advisors suggested the member search on YouTube for a video. One member mentioned he had researched the project himself and found it not a very easy job to do: you have to be nearly as flexible as a contortionist! And please make sure you get all the wires out of the way – they are easy to get caught.

#### 4. HOW TO REFINISH A FACTORY HARDTOP

The caller owns a factory hardtop, which at some point was repainted with a shiny paint and would like to repaint it. Should he stick to the original factory colors of white or black or paint it to match his car?

#### **ADVICE:**

Hardtops only came in white and black from the factory.
But of course you are free to paint the hard top in any color to match your car unless you are trying to achieve concours status for your car.

#### 5. PREPPING YOUR HEALEY FOR WINTER

- ♦ Take your battery out and either hook up a trickle charger or just store it. The technical advisors also discussed the use of CTEK or BatteryTender chargers, which are designed to test your battery condition, keep the battery charged and monitor it to maximum battery life and performance. These chargers are readily available online for approx. \$ 50.00
- ♦ Top off your fuel tank, add the appropriate amount of Star Tron fuel stabilizer and run the engine for a little while to distribute stabilizer through fuel system.
- ◆ Check and top off the antifreeze

  NOTE: if you converted to an aluminum radiator, make sure you use the appropriate
  antifreeze which is especially formulated for aluminum.
- ♦ Install your top up and roll up your windows or install your side curtains.
- ♦ Pump up your tires
- ♦ Last, but not least: set out your favorite mouse trapping devices baited with peanut butter and peppermint scented deterrents, or store your Healey inside an inflatable CarJacket storage bag. Available from CarBag for approx. \$ 250.00 − make sure you follow their directions.

#### JENSEN HEALEY VIDEO CLIP

Our Video of the Week this time round features the short-lived collaboration between the folks and Jensen and Donald Healey. The Jensen Healey has long been one of personal favorites with a body style that seems somewhere between a muscular Spitfire and a slimmed down Mustang, a Lotus engine, and a comfortable, almost plush, interior.

For those who don't know, or have forgotten with our increasing age, the **Jensen Healey** was a two-seater convertible sports car, in true British fashion, produced from 1972 to 1976. Even though it was only produced for about 4 years, it was the best selling Jensen of all time. In total 10,503 (10 prototypes, 3,347 Mk.1 and 7,146 Mk.2) were produced by Jensen Motors Ltd. in **West Bromwich**. A related and rare fastback, the **Jensen GT**, was introduced in 1975 but did not include the Healey badging.

Launched in 1972 as a fast luxurious and competent convertible sports car, the Jensen Healey was positioned in the market between the **Triumph TR6** and the **Jaguar E-Type**. The 50/50 weight balance due to the all alloy Lotus engine led to universal praise as having excellent handling and performance.


