### TECH SESSION at British Body and Coachworks, April 30th

More than 50 members of the AHC-NE and BCNH clubs showed up on a cool but sunny day in Fitzwilliam, NH to attend the Tech Session/ Open House hosted by Mark LeBlanc of British Body and Coachworks. Attendees enjoyed some hot coffee, apple cider, cider donuts and some delicious pies to sample. But it was the many cars that Mark has in his shop at various stages of restoration that caught everyone's attention. From almost two completed Big Healey's to a few skeleton Healey chassis, a TR4 waiting for primer and few other British cars in for some R&R, there was plenty for everyone to see.





After everyone spent time reviewing the cars in the shop Mark began his Tech Session on compounding and polishing paint. Mark first showed the various buffing pads he uses, and which machine works best for each application. He then reviewed the various compounds and polishes he uses from aggressive to mild applications



Mark then started to compound an old, weathered door from a Healey that may have been its original paint. After a few passes with his rotary buffer and aggressive compound the dull paint came to vivid life again. Mark next showed how to wet sand out imperfections in paint work before compounding and polishing. And finally, he moved on to a freshly wet sanded "boot" from a Healey to demonstrate the dual process of compounding and polishing to give



the paint its final luster. Mark mentioned a British car can take anywhere from 30 to 60 hours to wet sand, compound, and polish.

Everyone seemed to have enjoyed the Tech Session as well as viewing all the cars in his shop. Mark plans to hold another Tech Session and Open House in the fall so look for future details.
